11	Section 1. Section 1002, act of October 28, 1966 (1st
12	Sp.Sess., P.L.55, No.7), known as the "Goods and Services
13	Installment Sales Act," is deleted as follows:
14	[Section 1002. The Department of Banking of the Commonwealth
15	of Pennsylvania shall supply upon request to each retail seller
16	and financing agency, engaged in the extension of credit, a rate
17	chart with principal balances of from one dollar (\$1) to one
18	thousand dollars (\$1,000) for installment periods from three (3)
19	months to thirty-six (36) months and for principal balances of
20	from one dollar (\$1) to two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for

1 installment periods of from ten (10) weeks to twenty-six (26)
2 weeks calculated at the maximum service charge rates permitted
3 under this act.]

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
