AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for the registration of and
3 plates for electrically powered vehicles.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
8 amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1341.1. Plates for electrically powered vehicles.

10 A person who registers an electrically powered vehicle shall,
11 upon request, be entitled to a special plate bearing the
12 appropriate designation prescribed by the secretary without the
13 payment of any fee for the registration or for the plate. These
14 special plates shall have the same force and effect as regular
15 registration plates.

16 Section 2. Section 1919 of Title 75 (relating to electric
17 vehicles) is repealed.

18 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
