## AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 7, 1963 (P.L.549, No.290), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act creating the Pennsylvania Higher 3 Education Assistance Agency; defining its powers and duties; conferring powers and imposing duties on the Governor, 5 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Superintendent of Public Instruction and the 7 Department of Auditor General; and making appropriations," 8 requiring persons who receive assistance to be United States 9 citizens. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- 12 Section 1. Section 2 and clause (1) of section 4, act of
- August 7, 1963 (P.L.549, No.290), referred to as the 13
- 14 Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency Act, section 2
- amended January 18, 1968 (1967 P.L.952, No.424) and clause (1) 15
- of section 4 amended December 30, 1974 (P.L.1111, No.357), are 16

- 18 Section 2. Purpose. -- The purpose of such agency shall be to
- 19 improve the higher educational opportunities of persons who are
- 20 citizens of the United States and residents of this State and
- who are attending approved institutions of higher education, in 21

- 1 this State or elsewhere, by guaranteeing loans made to such
- 2 persons to assist them in meeting their expenses of higher
- 3 education in accordance with the provisions of this act.
- 4 Section 4. Powers and Duties. -- In furtherance of the
- 5 purposes set forth in this act, the board of directors shall
- 6 have the following powers:
- 7 (1) To guarantee loans of money upon such terms and
- 8 conditions as the board may prescribe within the limitations
- 9 contained herein, at such rates of interest as are determined by
- 10 the agency, to persons who are citizens of the United States and
- 11 residents of this State and who plan to attend or are attending
- 12 any approved institution of higher education eligible under this
- 13 act in this State or elsewhere to assist them in meeting their
- 14 expenses of higher education. No such person shall receive any
- 15 loan guarantee in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars
- 16 (\$1500) for any academic year and no such person shall receive a
- 17 total loan guarantee of more than seventy-five hundred dollars
- 18 (\$7500) except if such loans are guaranteed or reinsured under
- 19 Federal laws. Such loan guarantees shall become due and payable
- 20 at the direction of the board of directors and the board of
- 21 directors may extend the repayment period not to exceed fifteen
- 22 years from the date of execution of the note or other written
- 23 evidence of the loan or as allowed under Federal law when the
- 24 loan is guaranteed or reinsured under Federal laws.

- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
