- 1 WHEREAS, the National Rifle Association has been and remains
- 2 this country's most effective spokesman against the erosion of
- 3 the constitutional right to keep and bear arms; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the National Rifle Association correctly maintains
- 5 that the control of guns by government would leave law-abiding
- 6 citizens unarmed while criminals would continue to possess and
- 7 use guns; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the National Rifle Association recognizes that if
- 9 legislation were adopted to require the registration of
- 10 handguns, it would represent a giant step toward totally
- 11 disarming law-abiding American citizens; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the position of the National Rifle Association on
- 13 this crucially important issue represents the viewpoint of the
- 14 vast majority of Pennsylvanians; therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 16 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby goes on record as being in

- 1 complete support of the position of the National Rifle
- 2 Association on the subject of gun control legislation; and be it
- 3 further

- 5 hereby directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the
- 6 Honorable Jimmy Carter, President of the United States, to each
- 7 member of the Pennsylvania delegation to the United States
