- 1 The March 28, 1979 incident at the Three Mile Island Nuclear
- 2 Facility poses significant questions and threatens substantial
- 3 impact on the electric utility consumers served by Metropolitan
- 4 Edison Company and Pennsylvania Electric Company; and
- 5 The present accelerated timetable of the Pennsylvania Public
- 6 Utility Commission for hearings, argument and the apparent
- 7 granting of rate increases in the immediate future prevent the
- 8 General Assembly from adequate deliberation of the need for
- 9 legislative relief to the affected electric utility consumers;
- 10 therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the Pennsylvania
- 12 Public Utility Commission be directed to delay the granting of
- 13 any rate increases to the Metropolitan Edison Company and/or
- 14 Pennsylvania Electric Company for causes in any way occasioned
- 15 by the Three Mile Island incident for a period of 30 days from
- 16 the due adoption of this resolution.
