In the House of Representatives, October 10, 1979

1 The Federal mining regulations appear to be geared to the
2 mining of bituminous coal by large mining companies. Their
3 application to small anthracite coal companies is particularly
4 onerous. An investigation of the complaints concerning their
5 application to the hard coal industry in Pennsylvania would seem
6 to be in order; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Mines and Energy Management Committee of
8 this House of Representatives be directed to investigate the
9 impact of Federal mining regulations on small anthracite mine
10 operators; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That the committee make a report of its findings
12 and recommendations to this House of Representatives as soon as
13 possible.
