- 5 disabled people; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 7 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress and
- 8 President of the United States to exclude pensions from the
- 9 Federal Income Tax; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be sent to the
- 11 presiding officer of each House of the Congress of the United
- 12 States, to each Senator and Representative from Pennsylvania in
- 13 the Congress of the United States and to the President, Jimmy
- 14 Carter.
