- 8 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urges Congress and the President of
- 9 the United States to require oil companies to divest themselves
- 10 of all holdings not related to oil; and be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 12 the presiding officers of each House of the Congress of the
- 13 United States, to each Senator and Representative from
- 14 Pennsylvania in the Congress of the United States and to the
- 15 President, Jimmy Carter.
