In the House of Representatives, February 5, 1980

1 WHEREAS, Oil companies are using their enormous profits to
2 buy holdings not only in other sources of energy, but also in
3 other endeavors; and

4 WHEREAS, The profits used to buy other holdings should be
5 used to explore for and develop new sources of oil; therefore be
6 it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
8 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urges Congress and the President of
9 the United States to require oil companies to divest themselves
10 of all holdings not related to oil; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
12 the presiding officers of each House of the Congress of the
13 United States, to each Senator and Representative from
14 Pennsylvania in the Congress of the United States and to the
15 President, Jimmy Carter.
