- 6 WHEREAS, The Office of the Secretary of the Treasury is a
- 7 vital and influential job helping to shape our country's
- 8 monetary policy; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The department must be cleansed of any question of
- 10 unethical behavior; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 12 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memoralize the Attorney
- 13 General of the United States to appoint a special prosecutor to
- 14 investigate any possible wrongdoing of G. William Miller,
- 15 Secretary of the Treasury of the United States; and be it
