8	Section 1. Section 901, act of February 1, 1966 (1965	
9	P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The Borough Code," amended June 15,	
10	1978 (P.L.473, No.68), is amended to read:	
11	Section 901. Filling Vacancies in Elective Borough	
12	Offices (A) If any vacancy shall occur in the office of the	<—
13	mayor, member of council, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 901.1,	<—
14	auditor, controller, assessor, or tax collector, by death,	
15	resignation, removal from the borough, or from a ward in the	
16	case of a ward office, or by failure to take the required oath	
17	or to give bond as provided by law or ordinance, or in any other	
18	manner whatsoever, [the borough council shall fill such vacancy	<—

within thirty days] SUCH VACANCY SHALL BE FILLED BY THE 1 <-CITIZENS' VACANCY BOARD. THIS BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF SEVEN 2 3 REGISTERED ELECTORS WHO RESIDE IN THE BOROUGH. THESE MEMBERS 4 SHALL BE APPOINTED AT-LARGE FROM WITHIN THE BOROUGH BY THE 5 EXISTING MEMBERS OF COUNCIL THEN IN OFFICE AT THE COUNCIL'S 6 FIRST MEETING EACH CALENDAR YEAR. COUNCIL SHALL ALSO APPOINT ONE MEMBER TO SERVE AS CHAIRMAN OF THE CITIZENS' VACANCY BOARD. 7 WHENEVER A VACANCY OCCURS, THE CITIZENS' VACANCY BOARD SHALL 8 9 SUBMIT TO COUNCIL WITHIN FIFTEEN DAYS OF THE VACANCY THE NAMES 10 OF THREE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE BOROUGH TO FILL THE VACANCY. 11 THE MEMBERS OF THE CITIZENS' VACANCY BOARD ARE PROHIBITED FROM 12 SUBMITTING THE NAME OF ANY EXISTING MEMBER OF THE CITIZENS' 13 VACANCY BOARD TO FILL A VACANCY. THE FROM THIS LIST THE COUNCIL 14 SHALL FILL THE VACANCY WITHIN FIFTEEN DAYS OF RECEIVING THE LIST <----15 OF NAMES FROM THE CITIZENS' VACANCY BOARD by appointing, by 16 resolution, a registered elector of the borough, or of the ward 17 in case of a ward office, to hold such office, if the term 18 thereof continues so long, until the first Monday in January 19 after the first municipal election occurring more than sixty 20 days after the vacancy occurs, at which election an eligible 21 person shall be elected to the office for the remainder of the 22 term.

23 The person appointed shall give bond if required by law or 24 ordinance.

In cases where the person elected to the office shall fail to give bond, if any, required or to take the required oath, the borough council, before making the appointment, shall declare the office vacant.

within thirty days after the vacancy happens, as provided in 1 this section, then the vacancy shall be filled within fifteen 2 3 additional days by [a] the vacancy board. [to] Such board shall 4 consist of the borough council exclusive of the mayor, and one 5 registered elector of the borough who shall be [elected] appointed by the borough council at [each reorganizational 6 meeting of the council] the council's first meeting each 7 calendar year or as soon thereafter as practical and who shall 8 9 act as chairman of the vacancy board. The board shall appoint a 10 registered elector of the borough, (or ward in the case of a ward office), to hold such office, if the term thereof continues 11 so long, until the first Monday in January after the first 12 13 municipal election occurring more than sixty days after the 14 vacancy occurs, at which election an eligible person shall be 15 elected to the office for the remainder of the term. 16 If the vacancy is not filled by the vacancy board within 17 fifteen days, the chairman shall or in the case of a vacancy in 18 the chairmanship the remaining members of the vacancy board shall petition the court of common pleas to fill the vacancy by 19 20 the appointment of a registered elector of the borough (or ward 21 in the case of a ward), to hold such office, if the term thereof 22 continues so long, until the first Monday in January after the 23 first municipal election occurring more than sixty days after 24 the vacancy occurs, at which election an eligible person shall 25 be elected to the office for the remainder of the term. In the 26 case where there are vacancies in more than a majority of the 27 offices of council, the court of common pleas shall fill such 28 vacancies upon presentation of petition signed by not less than 29 fifteen registered electors of the borough.

1 OR BE UNABLE, FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER, TO FILL ANY VACANCY 2 WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE VACANCY HAPPENS, AS PROVIDED IN 3 THIS SECTION, THEN THE VACANCY SHALL BE FILLED WITHIN FIFTEEN 4 ADDITIONAL DAYS BY A VACANCY BOARD, TO CONSIST OF THE BOROUGH 5 COUNCIL EXCLUSIVE OF THE MAYOR, AND ONE REGISTERED ELECTOR OF THE BOROUGH WHO SHALL BE ELECTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL AT EACH 6 7 REORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL AND WHO SHALL ACT AS 8 CHAIRMAN OF THE VACANCY BOARD. THE BOARD SHALL APPOINT A 9 REGISTERED ELECTOR OF THE BOROUGH, (OR WARD IN THE CASE OF A 10 WARD OFFICE), TO HOLD SUCH OFFICE, IF THE TERM THEREOF CONTINUES 11 SO LONG, UNTIL THE FIRST MONDAY IN JANUARY AFTER THE FIRST MUNICIPAL ELECTION OCCURRING MORE THAN SIXTY DAYS AFTER THE 12 13 VACANCY OCCURS, AT WHICH ELECTION AN ELIGIBLE PERSON SHALL BE 14 ELECTED TO THE OFFICE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM.

15 IF THE VACANCY IS NOT FILLED BY THE VACANCY BOARD WITHIN 16 FIFTEEN DAYS, THE CHAIRMAN SHALL PETITION THE COURT OF COMMON 17 PLEAS TO FILL THE VACANCY BY THE APPOINTMENT OF A REGISTERED 18 ELECTOR OF THE BOROUGH (OR WARD IN THE CASE OF A WARD), TO HOLD 19 SUCH OFFICE, IF THE TERM THEREOF CONTINUES SO LONG, UNTIL THE 20 FIRST MONDAY IN JANUARY AFTER THE FIRST MUNICIPAL ELECTION 21 OCCURRING MORE THAN SIXTY DAYS AFTER THE VACANCY OCCURS, AT 22 WHICH ELECTION AN ELIGIBLE PERSON SHALL BE ELECTED TO THE OFFICE 23 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM.]

24 (B) WHENEVER THE COUNCIL SHALL FAIL TO FILL A VACANCY WITHIN FIFTEEN DAYS OF RECEIVING THE LIST OF NAMES FROM THE CITIZENS' 25 26 VACANCY BOARD, THE LIST SHALL BE SUBMITTED BY THE CITIZENS' 27 VACANCY BOARD TO THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS. FROM THIS LIST THE 28 COURT SHALL APPOINT A REGISTERED ELECTOR OF THE BOROUGH (OR WARD IN THE CASE OF A WARD OFFICE), TO HOLD SUCH OFFICE, IF THE TERM 29 THEREOF CONTINUES SO LONG, UNTIL THE FIRST MONDAY IN JANUARY 30 19810H0022B2146

1 AFTER THE FIRST MUNICIPAL ELECTION OCCURRING MORE THAN SIXTY 2 DAYS AFTER THE VACANCY OCCURS, AT WHICH ELECTION AN ELIGIBLE 3 PERSON SHALL BE ELECTED TO THE OFFICE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE 4 TERM. 5 (C) WHENEVER THE CITIZENS' VACANCY BOARD FAILS TO SUBMIT A LIST OF REGISTERED ELECTORS TO COUNCIL WITHIN FIFTEEN DAYS THE 6 7 COURT OF COMMON PLEAS SHALL FILL THE VACANCY UPON PRESENTATION 8 OF A PETITION SIGNED BY NOT LESS THAN FIFTEEN REGISTERED 9 ELECTORS OF THE BOROUGH. THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS SHALL FILL 10 THE VACANCY BY THE APPOINTMENT OF A REGISTERED ELECTOR OF THE 11 BOROUGH TO HOLD SUCH OFFICE IF THE TERM CONTINUES SO LONG, UNTIL 12 THE FIRST MONDAY IN JANUARY AFTER THE FIRST MUNICIPAL ELECTION 13 OCCURRING MORE THAN SIXTY DAYS AFTER THE VACANCY OCCURS, AT 14 WHICH ELECTION AN ELIGIBLE PERSON SHALL BE ELECTED TO THE OFFICE 15 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM. 16 SECTION 2. THE ACT IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ: 17 SECTION 901.1. EMERGENCY ACTION; VACANCIES OF A MAJORITY 18 NUMBER OF COUNCIL.--(A) WHERE THERE ARE VACANCIES IN MORE THAN 19 A MAJORITY OF THE OFFICES OF COUNCIL, THE VACANCIES SHALL BE 20 FILLED BY THE CITIZENS' VACANCY BOARD. THE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT TO 21 THE EXISTING MEMBERS OF COUNCIL THEN IN OFFICE THE NAME OR NAMES 22 OF A REGISTERED ELECTOR OR ELECTORS OF THE BOROUGH TO FILL THE 23 VACANCY OR VACANCIES. THE NUMBER OF NAMES SUBMITTED BY THE BOARD 24 SHALL EXCEED BY TWO THE NUMBER OF APPOINTEES NECESSARY TO FILL 25 THE VACANCIES. FROM THIS LIST THE EXISTING MEMBERS OF COUNCIL 26 THEN IN OFFICE SHALL FILL VACANCIES BY APPOINTING BY RESOLUTION 27 REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE BOROUGH TO HOLD SUCH OFFICES, IF THE 28 TERM THEREOF CONTINUES SO LONG, UNTIL THE FIRST MONDAY IN 29 JANUARY AFTER THE FIRST MUNICIPAL ELECTION OCCURRING MORE THAN 30 SIXTY DAYS AFTER THE VACANCIES OCCUR, AT WHICH ELECTION AN 19810H0022B2146 - 5 -
