AN ACT

Amending the act of July 20, 1968 (P.L.652, No.220), entitled 2 "An act amending the act of March 31, 1949 (P.L.372, No.34), 3 entitled 'An act to promote the welfare of the people of the 4 Commonwealth; creating The General State Authority as a body corporate and politic with power to construct, improve, 5 6 equip, furnish, and operate projects, and to lease the same, 7 and to fix fees, rentals, and charges for the use thereof; 8 authorizing and regulating the issuance of bonds for said Authority, and providing for the payment of such bonds, and 9 10 the rights of the holders thereof; and to enter into 11 agreements with the Government of the United States or any 12 Federal agency; and authorizing the Department of Property 13 and Supplies to grant, assign, convey, or lease to the 14 Authority lands of the Commonwealth and interests therein, 15 and to acquire lands therefor; granting the right of eminent domain; empowering The General State Authority to sell and 16 17 convey projects and property to the Commonwealth; and providing that no debt of the Commonwealth shall be incurred 18 19 in the exercise of any of the powers granted by this act, ' empowering the Authority to construct and acquire projects 20 21 -certain State related universities; providing for the 22 disposition of unused borrowing capacity which may become available through the operation of the Higher Education 23 Facilities Act of 1963 or other Federal grants; harmonizing 24 25 the language of certain existing amendments; allocating 26 unused funds; providing for the interpretation of certain 27 amendments to the act; further defining the powers and 28 procedures of the board; regulating the leasing of projects 29 constructed for State aided institutions; amending the 30 eminent domain powers and procedures of the Authority; 31 specifically itemizing projects for capital budget purposes, "

1 authorizing the acquisition and demolition of properties for 2 the Yellow Creek and Two Lick Creek Flood Protection Project. 3 AMENDING THE ACT OF OCTOBER 5, 1972 (SP.SESS., NO.1, P.L.2019, NO.4), ENTITLED, AS AMENDED, "AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE 4 5 PROVISIONS OF CLAUSE (1) OF SUBSECTION (A) OF SECTION 7 OF 6 ARTICLE VIII OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF 7 PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE INCURRING OF DEBT FOR THE 8 REHABILITATION OF AREAS AFFECTED BY THE GREAT STORM AND 9 FLOODS OF SEPTEMBER, 1971 AND JUNE, 1972, AND THE GREAT FLOOD 10 OF JULY, 1977 THROUGH URBAN REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE; 11 IMPOSING DUTIES UPON THE GOVERNOR, THE AUDITOR GENERAL AND 12 STATE TREASURER; PRESCRIBING THE PROCEDURES FOR THE ISSUANCE, 13 SALE AND PAYMENT OF GENERAL OBLIGATIONS BONDS, THE FUNDING OF 14 DEBT AND REFUNDING OF BONDS; EXEMPTING SAID BONDS FROM STATE 15 AND LOCAL TAXATION; CREATING CERTAIN FUNDS; AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, " PROVIDING FOR THE BORROWING, DISPOSITION AND 16 17 APPROPRIATION OF AN ADDITIONAL SUM. 18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 19 hereby enacts as follows: 20 Section 1. - 6 SECTION 3. DISPOSITION AND USE OF PROCEEDS.--* * *
- 7 (D) SUBJECT TO THE TOTAL LIMIT OF [FIFTY MILLION DOLLARS
- 8 (\$50,000,000)] FIFTY-TWO MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND
- 9 <u>DOLLARS (\$52,708,000)</u>, THE FUNDS AUTHORIZED TO BE BORROWED BY

- 19 AFFAIRS. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ACT OR ANY
- 20 OTHER ACT, DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR REHABILITATION OF
- 21 ALL REAL PROPERTY DAMAGED BY THE GREAT STORM AND FLOOD OF JULY,
- 22 1977, SHALL BE MADE TO PERSONS OWNING SUCH REAL PROPERTY IN SUCH
- 23 A MANNER THAT THE INCOME OF SUCH PERSONS IS NOT USED IN ANY WAY
- 24 TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDS UNDER THIS ACT.

- 26 SECTION 3. SECTION 12 OF THE ACT, AMENDED OCTOBER 4, 1978
- 27 (P.L.969, NO.191), IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 28 SECTION 12. APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS.--THE NET PROCEEDS OF
- 29 THE SALE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY MILLION DOLLARS (\$140,000,000)
- 30 OF OBLIGATIONS HEREIN AUTHORIZED ARE HEREBY APPROPRIATED FROM

- THE DISASTER RELIEF FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS
- 2 TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF REHABILITATION OF AREAS AFFECTED BY THE
- 3 SEPTEMBER, 1971 AND JUNE, 1972 AND JULY, 1977 DISASTERS THROUGH
- 4 URBAN REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE. THE NET PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE
- 5 OF THE [FIFTY MILLION DOLLARS (\$50,000,000)] FIFTY-TWO MILLION
- 6 SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$52,708,000) OF
- 7 OBLIGATIONS HEREIN AUTHORIZED ARE HEREBY APPROPRIATED FROM THE
- 8 DISASTER RELIEF FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS TO
- 9 DEFRAY THE COSTS OF REHABILITATION OF AREAS AFFECTED BY THE
- 10 JULY, 1977 DISASTER THROUGH URBAN REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE.
- 11 AFTER RESERVING OR PAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE SALE OF THE
- 12 OBLIGATION, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL PAY THE MONEYS AS REQUIRED
- 13 AND CERTIFIED BY THE GOVERNOR.
- 14 SECTION 4. THE ADDITIONAL \$2,708,000 AUTHORIZED IN THIS ACT
- 15 ARE PROVIDED FOR THE COMPLETION OF ACQUISITION AND SITE
- 16 CLEARANCE OF THE FLOODWAY AREA IN THE BOROUGH OF HOMER CITY AND
- 17 CENTER TOWNSHIP, INDIANA COUNTY.
- 18 SECTION 5. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
