## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled 2 "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending,
- 3 revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto,"
- 4 authorizing real estate tax reductions for certain senior
- 5 citizens.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), known
- 9 as the "Third Class City Code," reenacted and amended June 28,
- 10 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended by adding a section to read:
- 11 <u>Section 2531.2. Real Estate Tax Reductions for Senior</u>
- 12 Citizens. -- The city may establish a uniform system of real
- 13 estate tax reductions for residential property belonging to any
- 14 person sixty-five years of age or older, or whose spouse is
- 15 sixty-five years of age or older, and whose total annual
- 16 household income is nine thousand dollars (\$9,000) or less.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
