#### AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of July 3, 1947 (P.L.1242, No.507), entitled "An act relating to police and firemen's pension funds in cities of the second class A, and directing such cities to appropriate certain moneys thereto, and requiring reports and audits," further providing for credit for certain military service in the armed forces of the United States.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 1, act of July 3, 1947 (P.L.1242,
10	No.507), entitled "An act relating to police and firemen's
11	pension funds in cities of the second class A, and directing
12	such cities to appropriate certain moneys thereto, and requiring
13	reports and audits," amended July 15, 1968 (P.L.341, No.166), is
14	amended to read:
15	Section 1. There shall be paid over, as hereinafter
16	provided, to the organization or association constituting and
17	having in charge the distribution of police and firemen's
18	pension funds in every city of the second class A, three per
19	centum (3%) of all city taxes collected by the city, other than

taxes levied to pay interest on or to extinguish the debt of the 1 city, or any part thereof, to be divided equally between the 2 3 police and firemen's association or organization. In addition to 4 the three per centum (3%) of city taxes required to be paid 5 pursuant to this section, moneys shall be appropriated by cities of the second class A to organizations and associations 6 distributing police and firemen's pension funds, whenever 7 necessary to enable the organizations or associations to pay the 8 9 amounts of minimum pensions prescribed by act of Assembly, 10 pursuant to section [11] <u>26</u> of article III. of the Constitution 11 of Pennsylvania. In addition to the above payments and 12 appropriations, moneys may be appropriated by cities of the 13 second class A to organizations and associations distributing 14 police and firemen's pension funds, whenever necessary, to 15 entitle any policeman or fireman who [is] has been a member of 16 the pension fund for a period of at least five (5) years and who 17 served in the armed forces of the United States subsequent to 18 September 1, 1940, and who was not a member of the police or 19 firemen's pension funds prior to such military service, [and who 20 commenced employment as a policeman or fireman in a city of the 21 second class A within three (3) years from date of release from 22 active duty] to have full credit for each year or fraction 23 thereof, not to exceed five (5) years of such <u>military</u> service\_ 24 upon his payment to the police or firemen's pension fund an 25 amount equal to that which he would have paid had he been a 26 member during the period for which he desires credit computed 27 with reference to the compensation he received upon entry into 28 city service as a policeman or fireman and his current percentage of salary deductions, and an additional amount as the 29 30 equivalent of the contributions of the city on account of such - 2 -19810H1041B1143

military service, which amount may be paid in a lump sum or by
installments as may be approved by the organizations or
associations distributing pension funds to police and firemen.
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
