## AN ACT

Declaring and adopting the song "Pennsylvania," by Ethel Lodge, 2 as the State song of the Commonwealth. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 5 Section 1. The song "Pennsylvania," words and music by Ethel Lodge, is hereby adopted as the State song of Pennsylvania and 7 shall be the official song for all public purposes.
