13	SECTION 1. THE ACT OF JUNE 1, 1945 (P.L.1242, NO.428), KNOWN	<
14	AS THE "STATE HIGHWAY LAW," IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO

16	SECTION 222. NEGOTIATIONS FOR VOLUNTARY TURN BACK ON CERTAIN

5 SECTION 2. SECTION 401 OF THE ACT IS AMENDED TO READ: 6 Section 401. Duty on Department of [Highways] 7 <u>Transportation.--(a)</u> The department shall construct or improve, 8 and thereafter maintain and repair, at the cost and expense of 9 the Commonwealth, the highways forming the plan or system of the 10 State highways, in the several counties and townships. Such 11 improvement and maintenance shall be made according to 12 specifications to be prepared by the department, as regards the 13 character, construction, and material to be used. The work of construction and maintenance of said State highways shall be 14 15 done under the direction and supervision of the secretary. The 16 secretary, in addition to the powers conferred [upon him in] by 17 this act, shall enjoy and possess, in the construction and 18 maintenance of State highways, all the rights and powers 19 conferred by existing laws on supervisors or commissioners in 20 townships in the construction or maintenance of township roads. 21 (b) Except as otherwise expressly provided by this act, or 22 except as otherwise expressly provided by contract or agreement 23 entered into pursuant to this act, the responsibility for 24 maintenance or repair of any State highway shall not be deemed to be LIE with the municipality in which the highway or any 25 26 portion thereof is located. nor shall the municipality, or any 27 officer or employe thereof, be subject to liability for personal 28 injury or property damage resulting from failure of the 29 Commonwealth to properly maintain or repair said highway. 30 Section 2 3.
