AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto, "increasing the level of income for 6 certain exemptions. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 679, act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," amended 10
- 11 October 4, 1978 (P.L.943, No.184), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 679. Per Capita Taxes. -- Each resident or inhabitant,
- over eighteen years of age, in every school district of the 13
- 14 second, third, and fourth class, which shall levy such tax,
- shall annually pay, for the use of the school district in which 15
- 16 he or she is a resident or inhabitant, a per capita tax of not
- 17 less than one dollar nor more than five dollars, as may be
- assessed by the local school district. The tax collector shall 18
- not proceed against a spouse or his employer until he has 19

- 1 pursued remedies against the delinquent taxpayer and the
- 2 taxpayer's employer under this section.
- 3 Each school district may exempt any person whose total income
- 4 from all sources is less than [two thousand dollars] seven
- 5 thousand five hundred dollars per annum from its per capita tax
- 6 or any portion thereof. The school district may adopt and employ
- 7 regulations for the processing of claims for the exemption.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
