AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the  
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for  
3 certain juveniles convicted in criminal proceedings.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 6355 of Title 42, act of November 25,  
7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
8 Statutes, is amended by adding a subsection to read:

9 § 6355. Transfer to criminal proceedings.

10 \* \* \*

11 (g) Chapter inapplicable following conviction.--A conviction  
12 of a juvenile in a criminal proceeding following transfer shall  
13 thereafter render this chapter inapplicable to that juvenile in  
14 relation to criminal offenses.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days and shall  
16 apply to convictions rendered on and after that date.
