## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 22, 1970 (P.L.513, No.178), entitled 2 "An act imposing a tax on the sale or possession of cigarettes and providing penalties," reducing commissions for 3 stamping agencies, providing for the disposition of money 4 5 saved thereby, creating the Softball Fund and providing for duties of the Department of Community Affairs. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 302, act of July 22, 1970 (P.L.513,

- 10 No.178), known as the "Pennsylvania Cigarette Tax Act," is
- 11 repealed.
- 12 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- Section 302.1. Appropriation. -- (a) One-half of the amount 13
- of moneys formerly allowed cigarette stamping agencies under 14
- 15 section 302 of this act during the last effective year of that
- section are hereby appropriated on an annual basis to the 16
- 17 Softball Fund.
- 18 (b) There is hereby created the Softball Fund separate and
- apart from other public moneys of the Commonwealth. This fund 19

- shall be administered by the Department of Community Affairs and
- 2 <u>shall be used for grants to girls softball, little league</u>
- 3 <u>baseball</u> and pee wee football programs.
- 4 (c) The Department of Community Affairs shall, in the manner
- provided by law, promulgate the rules, regulations and forms 5
- necessary to carry out this section.
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1 next following
- 8 the date of final enactment.
