## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," further providing for compensation of commissioners.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 703, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569) and amended November 9, 1977 (P.L.230, No. 72), is amended to read:

Section 703. Compensation.--Each township commissioner shall receive a salary of not more than [eight hundred] one thousand dollars per year in townships having a population of less than four thousand, not more than [twelve hundred] fifteen hundred dollars per year in townships having a population of four thousand and more but less than ten thousand, not more than [fifteen hundred] two thousand dollars per year in townships having a population of ten thousand and more but less than
fifteen thousand, not more than [twenty-four hundred] three thousand dollars in townships having a population of not less than fifteen thousand and not more than twenty-five thousand, and not more than [three thousand] thirty-seven hundred fifty dollars in townships having a population in excess of twentyfive thousand. Such salaries shall be payable monthly or quarterly for the duties imposed by the provisions of this act. Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
