AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
4 thereto," further providing for compensation of
5 commissioners.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 703, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206,
9 No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and
10 amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569) and amended November 9,
11 1977 (P.L.230, No.72), is amended to read:

12 Section 703. Compensation.--Each township commissioner shall
13 receive a salary of not more than [eight hundred] one thousand
14 dollars per year in townships having a population of less than
15 four thousand, not more than [twelve hundred] fifteen hundred
16 dollars per year in townships having a population of four
17 thousand and more but less than ten thousand, not more than
18 [fifteen hundred] two thousand dollars per year in townships
19 having a population of ten thousand and more but less than

1 fifteen thousand, not more than [twenty-four hundred] three
2 thousand dollars in townships having a population of not less
3 than fifteen thousand and not more than twenty-five thousand,
4 and not more than [three thousand] thirty-seven hundred fifty
5 dollars in townships having a population in excess of twenty-
6 five thousand. Such salaries shall be payable monthly or
7 quarterly for the duties imposed by the provisions of this act.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
