AN ACT

1 Relating to caffeine pills and providing penalties.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 Section 1. Caffeine pills.

5 Caffeine pills shall hereafter be sold only in registered
6 pharmacies or otherwise dispensed by a physician.

7 Section 2. Sale to persons under 18 prohibited.

8 No person shall sell any caffeine pills to any minor under 18
9 years of age.

10 Section 3. Penalty.

11 Whoever violates any provision of this act is guilty of a
12 misdemeanor of the third degree.

13 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
