AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for offenses against a
- 3 person using a guide dog because of deafness.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 7325 of Title 18, act of November 25,
- 7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 9 § 7325. Discrimination on account of guide dog.
- 10 A person is guilty of a summary offense if he, being the
- 11 proprietor, manager or employee of a theatre, hotel, restaurant
- 12 or other place of public entertainment or amusement, refuses,
- 13 withholds or denies any [blind] person, who is using a [seeing
- 14 eye] guide dog, because of the blindness or deafness of the
- 15 user, the use of or access to any accommodation, advantage,
- 16 facility or privilege of such theatre, hotel, restaurant or
- 17 other place of public entertainment or amusement.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
