## AN ACT

1	Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2	"An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3	executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4	Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5	departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6	including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7	Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8	authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9	departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10	duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11	officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12	boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13	Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14	and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15	certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16	other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17	and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18	number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19	assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20	commissions shall be determined," raising the amount of
21	payments to institutions.
22	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

23 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause (e) of section 1411, act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," added December 30, 1959 (P.L.2082, No.767), is amended to read: Section 1411. State Veterans Commission.--The State Veterans
 Commission shall have the power, and its duty shall be:
 \* \* \*

4 (e) To certify for payment gratuities for the children, 5 between the ages of sixteen and twenty-one years, of totally disabled veterans and of soldiers, marines, female clerks, 6 7 yeoman (female), or members of the Enlisted Nurse Corps of the United States, who die or have died of Spanish-American War or 8 World War I. service connected disabilities, and of totally 9 10 disabled veterans and of members of the Armed Forces of the 11 United States and of women's organizations officially connected therewith, who die or have died of World War II., or the armed 12 13 conflict in Korea service connected disabilities as certified from Veterans Administration records. Such children must have 14 15 lived in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for five years 16 immediately preceding the date upon which the application was 17 filed. Certification by the State Veterans' Commission shall be 18 made when the children meet the following requirements:

19 (1) As coming within the class of children described above, 20 (2) As attending any State or State-aided educational or 21 training institution of a secondary or college grade or other 22 institution of higher education, business school, trade school, hospital providing training for nurses school, or institution 23 24 providing courses in beauty culture, art, radio or undertaking 25 or embalming or such other educational training within this 26 Commonwealth as approved by the State Veterans' Commission, and 27 (3) As being unable, without such gratuity, to pursue his or 28 her education or training.

29 Payments not exceeding [two hundred dollars (\$200)] <u>five</u>
30 <u>hundred dollars (\$500)</u> per semester <u>or term</u> per child shall be

made to such institution upon the submission by them of proof 1 that bills have been incurred or contracted for matriculation 2 3 fees and other necessary fees, tuition, board, room rent, books 4 and supplies for such children in a definite amount for the school year. Such proof shall be submitted to the State 5 Veterans' Commission which shall attach the same to the 6 requisitions prepared for payments out of appropriations made 7 8 for such purpose.

9 When a child within the class of children eligible to receive 10 a gratuity authorized by this section is completing an 11 educational or training course, and becomes twenty-one years of 12 age before completing the course, the gratuity may be paid until 13 the course is completed: Provided, That gratuities may not be 14 paid for any child for a longer period than four scholastic 15 years.

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
