AN ACT

1 Repealing certain provisions of the act of April 21, 1949
2 (P.L.665, No.155), entitled "An act to carry into effect
3 section one of article fifteen of the Constitution, giving
4 cities of the first class the right and power to frame, adopt
5 and amend their own charters and to exercise the powers and
6 authority of local self-government, and providing the
7 procedure therefor; imposing certain restrictions,
8 limitations and regulations; imposing duties upon city
9 councils, city officers, county boards of elections, courts
10 and the Secretary of the Commonwealth; and providing for the
11 payment of certain expenses by such cities; and imposing
12 penalties," relating to the regulation of public education in
13 first class cities.

14 The General Assembly finds that the present method of
15 operating the system of public education in cities of the first
16 class will be improved by removing whatever limitations exist in
17 the "First Class City Home Rule Act" relating to the regulation
18 of public education and the administration thereof.

19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
20 hereby enacts as follows:

21 Section 1. Subclause (6) of clause (a) of section 18, act of
22 April 21, 1949 (P.L.665, No.155), known as the "First Class City
23 Home Rule Act," is repealed.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
