AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.926, No.369), entitled "An act for the protection of the public health by regulating the 3 conduct and operation of public eating and drinking places within this Commonwealth; requiring their licensing; imposing 5 certain duties on the Department of Health of this Commonwealth and on the local health authorities; and 6 7 providing penalties, "providing for the display of a placard and for legal duties and liability relating to choking emergencies.
- 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 11
- 12 The act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.926, No.369),
- 13 entitled "An act for the protection of the public health by

- 1 providing penalties, " is amended by adding sections to read:
- 2 <u>Section 9.1. In every public eating or drinking place there</u>
- 3 shall be conspicuously displayed a placard describing first aid
- 4 techniques which should be administered to a person who has food
- 5 particles lodged in his throat and is choking.
- 6 Section 9.2. Nothing contained in section 9.1 or otherwise
- 7 <u>shall impose any duty or obligation of any proprietor, employe</u>
- 8 or other person to remove, assist in removing or attempt to
- 9 remove food from the throat of the victim of a choking
- 10 <u>emergency</u>.
- 11 Section 9.3. A proprietor, employe or other person who
- 12 <u>voluntarily and without expectation of monetary compensation</u>
- 13 removes, assists in removing or attempts to remove food from the
- 14 throat of the victim of a choking emergency shall not be liable
- 15 for damages for injuries alleged to have been sustained by such
- 16 <u>victim unless it is established that such injuries were, or such</u>
- 17 death was, caused by gross negligence on the part of such
- 18 proprietor, employe or person.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
