- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing that the transcript
- of public hearings be considered part of the record in
- 4 proceedings before the commission.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 332(d) of Title 66, act of November 25,
- 8 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 9 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 10 § 332. Procedures in general.
- 11 * * *
- 12 (d) Record, briefs and argument.--The transcript of a public
- 13 hearing, the transcript of testimony and exhibits, together with
- 14 all papers and requests filed in the proceeding, constitutes the
- 15 exclusive record for decision, and shall be available for

- 1 inspection by the public. Briefing and oral argument shall be
- 2 held in accordance with rules established by the commission.

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
