AN ACT

Amending the act of October 30, 1981 (P.L.321, No.114), entitled 2 "An act prohibiting political subdivisions or agencies of the 3 Commonwealth from imposing certain quotas on the issuance of citations for certain offenses, " providing that certain 5 evaluations of officers shall not be prohibited, further providing for the enforcement of tickets or citations, 7 creating an offense and imposing a penalty. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2, act of October 30, 1981 (P.L.321, 10 No.114), entitled "An act prohibiting political subdivisions or 11 12 agencies of the Commonwealth from imposing certain quotas on the 13 issuance of citations for certain offenses," is amended to read: 14 Section 2. [Any tickets or citations issued in violation of 15 this act shall be unenforceable, null and void.] Any official of a political subdivision or agency of the Commonwealth who 16 orders, mandates, requires or in any other manner, directly or 17 18 indirectly, suggests that any officer mentioned in section 1 issue a certain number of traffic citations, tickets or any 19 20 other type of citation on a daily, weekly, monthly, quarterly or

- 1 yearly basis commits a summary offense and upon conviction shall
- 2 <u>be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$100 and not more</u>
- 3 than \$300 and the costs of prosecution for each offense.
- 4 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 5 Section 2.1. Nothing in this act shall be construed to
- 6 prohibit or deter the supervisor of any officer mentioned in
- 7 <u>section 1 from evaluating the officer's traffic enforcement</u>
- 8 performance and citing any deficiency in such performance.
- 9 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
