AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 31, 1971 (P.L.398, No.96), entitled  
2 "An act providing for the creation, maintenance and operation  
3 of a county employees' retirement system, and imposing certain  
4 charges on counties and providing penalties," providing for  
5 credit for former employees of school districts.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The act of August 31, 1971 (P.L.398, No.96),  
9 known as the County Pension Law, is amended by adding a section  
10 to read:

11 Section 13.1. Credit for Public School Service.--Any county  
12 employee who, on or after July 1, 1982 is employed by the county  
13 for a period of one month and who, on or immediately prior to  
14 July 1, 1982 was an employee of a public school district, shall  
15 have credited to the employee's employment record, for retirement  
16 benefits, all the time spent by such employee in the school  
17 district: Provided, however, That (i) the employee contribute to  
18 the fund the total amount of employee accumulated deductions  
19 withdrawn from the Public School Employees' Retirement Fund,

1 (ii) that the board of the Public School Employees' Retirement  
2 Fund transfer over within thirty days of receipt of a written  
3 request from the county the total amount of employer  
4 contributions and the accumulated interest on such contribution  
5 and (iii) that the employe start work with the county within  
6 thirty days after leaving employment with the public school  
7 district. This section shall apply only where the transfer of  
8 employment from the public school district to the county was not  
9 voluntary on the part of the employe.

10       Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
