AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, adding an offense; and providing a
- 3 penalty.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 5903.1. Distribution of indecent materials by cable
- 9 television system.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- No person shall by means of a cable
- 11 <u>television system knowingly distribute any indecent material by</u>
- 12 wire or cable to subscribers of the system or knowingly provide
- 13 any indecent material for distribution.
- 14 (b) Presumption. -- A person is presumed to have knowledge of
- 15 the character or nature of material if the person has actual
- 16 notice of the nature of the material, whether or not the person
- 17 has precise notice of its contents.

- 1 (c) Grading.--A person who violates subsection (a) commits a
- 2 misdemeanor of the first degree.
- 3 (d) Definitions. -- As used in this section the following
- 4 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 5 subsection:
- 6 "Community standards." The standards of the community
- 7 <u>encompassed within the territorial area covered by a cable</u>
- 8 television franchise.
- 9 <u>"Distribute." Send, transmit, retransmit or otherwise pass</u>
- 10 through a cable television system.
- 11 <u>"Indecent material." Material which is a representation or</u>
- 12 <u>verbal description of a human sexual or excretory organ or</u>
- 13 function, nudity, ultimate sexual acts (normal or perverted or
- 14 actual or simulated) or masturbation and which under
- 15 <u>contemporary community standards for cable television is</u>
- 16 patently offensive.
- 17 "Knowingly." Having knowledge of the character or nature of
- 18 the material involved.
- 19 "Material." Any visual material shown on a cable television
- 20 system, whether or not accompanied by a soundtrack, or any sound
- 21 recording played on a cable television system.
- 22 "Person." An individual, partnership, association or
- 23 corporation. The term includes a franchisee.
- 24 <u>"Provide." Supply for use.</u>
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
