## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 18, 1974 (P.L.359, No.120), entitled "An act creating the Municipal Police Officers' Education and 2 3 Training Commission; providing for the commission's 4 membership, selection, compensation, and removal; providing for the powers and duties of the commission; providing for the appointment and duties of the chairman; providing for the 6 7 act's applicability to the civil service laws; requiring training by certain political subdivisions and police 8 departments; providing penalties for violation thereof; and 9 making an appropriation, "including first class cities within 10 11 the act; and making an appropriation. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 2(3) and (6) of the act of June 18, 1974 (P.L.359, No.120), referred to as the Municipal Police Education 15 16 and Training Law, clause (3) amended October 5, 1980 (P.L.692, 17 No.141), are amended to read: Section 2. Definitions. -- As used in this act: 18 \* \* \* 19 20 (3) "Police officer" means any full-time or part-time

employe, of a city, [other than a city of the first class,]

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- 1 borough, town, township or county police department assigned to
- 2 criminal and/or traffic law enforcement duties, and for the
- 3 purpose of training only, security officers of first class city
- 4 housing authority, but shall exclude persons employed to check
- 5 parking meters and/or to perform only administrative duties,
- 6 auxiliary and fire police.

- 8 (6) "Political subdivision" means any county, city, [other
- 9 than a city of the first class, | borough, incorporated town or
- 10 township.
- 11 Section 2. Section 4(a) of the act, amended December 22,
- 12 1981 (P.L.523, No.146), is amended to read:
- 13 Section 4. Commission Members; Selection, Compensation and
- 14 Removal.--(a) The commission shall be composed of [eighteen]
- 15 <u>nineteen</u> members as follows:
- 16 (1) The Secretary of the Department of Community Affairs.
- 17 (2) The Attorney General of the Commonwealth.
- 18 (3) The Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police, who
- 19 shall serve as chairman of the commission.
- 20 (4) A member of the Senate of Pennsylvania, to be appointed
- 21 by the President pro tempore of the Senate.
- 22 (5) A member of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives,
- 23 to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- 24 (6) Four elected officials of the various political
- 25 subdivisions of the Commonwealth, to be appointed by the
- 26 Governor; one to be a borough official, one a first class
- 27 township official, one a second class township official, and one
- 28 a city official.
- 29 (7) Four incumbent chiefs of police from the various
- 30 political subdivisions of the Commonwealth, to be appointed by

- 1 the Governor; at least one to be a chief of a borough police
- 2 department, at least one to be a chief of a township police
- 3 department, at least one to be a chief of a city police
- 4 department.
- 5 (8) One Federal Bureau of Investigation special agent-in-
- 6 charge to be appointed by the Governor.
- 7 (9) One educator qualified in the field of law enforcement,
- 8 to be appointed by the Governor.
- 9 (10) One member representing the public at large, to be
- 10 appointed by the Governor.
- 11 (11) Two noncommissioned police officers to be appointed by
- 12 the Governor.
- 13 (12) One resident of a city of the first class, having
- 14 police experience, to be appointed by the mayor thereof.

- 16 Section 3. The training requirements of section 4 of the act
- 17 shall not apply to any police officer employed by a city of the
- 18 first class on the effective date of this amendatory act, and
- 19 all of said officers shall be considered to be certified under
- 20 section 9 of the act.
- 21 Section 4. The sum of \$2,000,000 is hereby appropriated to
- 22 the City of Philadelphia for reimbursement for police services
- 23 rendered to State property and State sponsored activities within
- 24 the city for the fiscal year July 1, 1983 to June 30, 1984.
- 25 Section 5. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) this
- 26 act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 27 (b) Section 4 of this amendatory act shall take effect July
- 28 1, 1983 or, if enacted after that date, then immediately.
- 29 SECTION 4. THE SUM OF \$635,000, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE <-
- 30 NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1,

- 1 1983 TO JUNE 30, 1984 TO THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE FOR
- 2 REIMBURSEMENT TO CITIES OF THE FIRST CLASS FOR THE MINIMUM
- 3 COURSES OF STUDY AND TRAINING ESTABLISHED BY THE MUNICIPAL
- 4 POLICE OFFICERS' EDUCATION AND TRAINING COMMISSION.
- 5 SECTION 5. THE SUM OF \$139,300, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE
- 6 NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1,
- 7 1983 TO JUNE 30, 1984 TO THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE FOR
- 8 INSERVICE TRAINING GRANTS TO CITIES OF THE FIRST CLASS APPROVED
- 9 BY THE MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS' EDUCATION AND TRAINING
- 10 COMMISSION.
- 11 SECTION 6. THIS ACT SHALL BE RETROACTIVE TO JANUARY 1, 1984,
- 12 AND SHALL APPLY TO ANY TRAINEES OF CITIES OF THE FIRST CLASS IN
- 13 A TRAINING CLASS WHICH WAS INSTITUTED PRIOR TO AND COMMENCING
- 14 AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT.
- 15 SECTION 7. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
