AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of August 12, 1971 (P.L.313, No.78), entitled
- 2 "An act providing for elimination of discriminatory
- 3 provisions relating to compensation for services and
- 4 treatment under sickness and accident insurance contracts and
- 5 providing for nondiscriminatory reimbursement of sickness and
- 6 bodily injury claims thereunder, providing for the inclusion
- of nonprofit health insurance plans.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of August 12, 1971 (P.L.313,
- 11 No.78), entitled "An act providing for elimination of
- 12 discriminatory provisions relating to compensation for services
- 13 and treatment under sickness and accident insurance contracts

- 1 and providing for nondiscriminatory reimbursement of sickness
- 2 and bodily injury claims thereunder, amended June 22, 1978
- 3 (P.L.493, No.72), is amended to read:
- 4 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of any policy
- 5 of insurance, self-insured sickness, health and/or welfare plan

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- 6 or nonprofit health insurance plan A PROFESSIONAL HEALTH
- 7 SERVICES PLAN CORPORATION AS DEFINED IN 40 PA.C.S. CH. 63
- 8 (RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL HEALTH SERVICES PLAN CORPORATIONS)
- 9 providing benefits issued or renewed after the effective date of
- 10 this act, whenever such policy or plan provides for
- 11 reimbursement for any service which may be legally performed by
- 12 a person licensed under the laws of the Commonwealth for the
- 13 practice of medicine, osteopathy, dentistry, chiropractic,
- 14 podiatry, or physical therapy, reimbursement under such policy
- 15 or plan shall not be denied when such service is rendered by a
- 16 person so licensed.
- 17 SECTION 2. NO ADJUSTMENT IN RATES, PREMIUMS OR FEES,
- 18 NECESSITATED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT, SHALL BE MADE IN ANY
- 19 SICKNESS AND ACCIDENT CONTRACT FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM THE
- 20 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT OR THE ANNIVERSARY DATE OF THE
- 21 CONTRACT AS THEY ARE RENEWED AND ONLY THEN IF FOUND TO BE
- 22 INDISPUTABLY SUBSTANTIATED BY ACTUARIAL REVIEW OF ALL RECORDS BY
- 23 THE INSURANCE DEPARTMENT BASED UPON THE EXPERIENCE RATED
- 24 FACTORS. A CONTRACT PURCHASER SHALL HAVE THE OPTION TO DROP ANY
- 25 COVERAGE FOR A PARTICULAR SERVICE IF THE RATES, PREMIUMS OR FEES
- 26 ARE INCREASED AS A RESULT OF SUCH STUDY CONDUCTED BY THE
- 27 INSURANCE DEPARTMENT.
- 28 Section 2 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
