1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8	Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes from State and local taxation and making an appropriation," providing for the lump sum or yearly installment payment of large prizes at the option of the winner.
9	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10	hereby enacts as follows:
11	Section 1. The act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91),
12	known as the State Lottery Law, is amended by adding a section
13	to read:
14	Section 8.1. Payment of Prize MoneyPrize amounts of ten
15	thousand dollars (\$10,000) or greater shall be paid in a lump
16	sum or in yearly installments, at the option of the winner.
17	Section 2. This act shall apply to prizes won on and after
18	the effective date hereof.
19	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
