AN ACT

Amending the act of June 28, 1895 (P.L.408, No.289), entitled, as amended, "A supplement to the twenty-fourth section of an 3 act, entitled 'An act to provide revenue by taxation, approved the seventh day of June, one thousand eight hundred 5 and seventy-nine, 'approved the first day of June, one 6 thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, amending the twenty-7 fourth section, by providing for the payment by the State 8 Treasurer of the two per centum tax on premiums paid by 9 foreign fire insurance companies to the treasurers of the several cities, towns, townships and boroughs, within this 10 Commonwealth, " further providing for payment of tax proceeds. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 14 Section 1. Section 2(a) of the act of June 28, 1895 15 (P.L.408, No.289), entitled, as amended, "A supplement to the twenty-fourth section of an act, entitled 'An act to provide 16 17 revenue by taxation, approved the seventh day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, 'approved the first day 18 19 of June, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, amending 20 the twenty-fourth section, by providing for the payment by the 21 State Treasurer of the two per centum tax on premiums paid by

- 2 Commonwealth, amended March 13, 1974 (P.L.196, No.38), is
- 3 amended to read:
- 4 Section 2. (a) On and after the first day of January, one
- 5 thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and annually thereafter,
- 6 there shall be paid by the State Treasurer to the treasurers of
- 7 the several cities, towns, townships, and boroughs within the
- 8 Commonwealth, the entire net amount received from the two per
- 9 centum tax paid upon premiums by foreign fire insurance
- 10 companies. The amount to be paid to each of the treasurers of
- 11 the several cities, towns, townships, and boroughs shall be
- 12 based upon the return of said two per centum tax upon premiums
- 13 received from foreign fire insurance companies doing business
- 14 within the said cities, towns, townships, and boroughs, and
- 15 shall be proportionate to the premiums received by such
- 16 companies on account of insurance written upon property located
- 17 in such city, borough, town or township, as shown by the report
- 18 made to the Department of Revenue. Each city, borough, town or
- 19 township, receiving any payment from the State Treasurer
- 20 hereunder, shall forthwith pay the amount received to the relief
- 21 fund association of, or the pension fund covering the employes
- 22 of the fire department, or of such fire company, or fire
- 23 companies, paid or volunteer, now existing, or hereafter
- 24 organized, in such city, borough, town, or township, as is or
- 25 are engaged in the service of such city, borough, town or
- 26 township, and duly recognized as such by the council or
- 27 commissioners or supervisors, as the case may be, of such city,
- 28 borough, town, or township. In any borough, town or township in
- 29 which there is no fire department or fire company or companies,
- 30 the amount received by the treasurer of the borough, town or

- 1 township from said tax shall be forthwith paid to the relief
- 2 fund association, or pension fund of the fire department or fire
- 3 company or companies of any near or adjacent city, borough,
- 4 town, or township, the fire department or fire company or
- 5 companies of which afford fire protection to the inhabitants of
- 6 such borough, town, or township. Before payment of said tax to
- 7 the treasurer of any such borough, town, or township, the mayor,
- 8 in boroughs, and the secretary of the board of supervisors, in
- 9 towns, or townships, shall first certify to the Auditor General
- 10 that the fire department or fire company or companies of such
- 11 near or adjacent city, borough, town, or township afford fire
- 12 protection to the inhabitants of such borough, town, or
- 13 township: Provided, That if the fire department consists of paid
- 14 and volunteer firemen and the paid firemen shall be covered by a
- 15 pension fund, then the two per centum tax aforesaid shall be
- 16 divided equally between the relief fund association of the
- 17 volunteer firemen and the pension fund for the paid firemen: And
- 18 <u>further provided</u>, That if the fire department of a city,
- 19 borough, town or township consists of three or fewer paid
- 20 <u>firemen covered by a pension fund and volunteer firemen, the</u>
- 21 governing body may pay into the pension fund for the paid
- 22 firemen, an amount equal to the retirement contribution of the
- 23 paid firemen, not exceeding fifty per centum of the amount
- 24 received by the treasurer, and the balance shall be paid to the
- 25 relief fund association of the volunteer firemen. Warrants for
- 26 the above purposes shall be drawn by the Auditor General,
- 27 payable to the treasurers of the several cities, towns,
- 28 townships, and boroughs, in accordance with this act, whenever
- 29 there are sufficient funds in the State Treasury to pay the
- 30 same. All such fire insurance companies shall instruct their

- 1 agents to place conspicuously upon the said policies and in the
- 2 applications for said policies, if any, the exact name of the
- 3 city, borough, town or township wherein the insured property is
- 4 located in addition to the mailing address for said insured
- 5 property.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1984.
