AN ACT

Amending the act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), entitled 2 "A supplement to the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), 3 entitled 'An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 7 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 9 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 10 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 12 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 13 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 14 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 15 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 16 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 17 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 18 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 20 21 commissions shall be determined, 'implementing the addition 22 of section 4.1 to Article IV of the Constitution of 23 Pennsylvania; establishing the Office of Attorney General 24 elected by the citizens and setting forth powers and duties 25 of the Attorney General; creating an Office of General 26 Counsel and providing for legal services for Commonwealth 27 agencies; transferring, reorganizing or reconstituting 28 certain boards, commissions and agencies; placing certain 29 duties upon the courts and district attorneys; repealing 30 certain acts and parts of acts and making appropriations," 31 further providing for the duties of the Attorney General.

- 2 Section 1. Section 204 of the act of October 15, 1980
- 3 (P.L.950, No.164), known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, is
- 4 amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 5 Section 204. Legal advice and civil matters.
- 6 * * *
- 7 (g) General obligation bonds or tax anticipation notes. -- The
- 8 Attorney General shall perform any and all legal services
- 9 required with respect to the issuance of general obligation
- 10 bonds or tax anticipation notes of the Commonwealth. Such legal
- 11 <u>services shall be performed by one or more deputy or assistant</u>
- 12 attorneys general who are salaried employees of the office.
- 13 Under no circumstances shall such legal services be performed by
- 14 the retaining of outside bond counsel.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
