AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, adding an offense and providing a 2 3 penalty. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 5 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 4107.2. Deception relating to certification of minority 9 business enterprise OR WOMEN'S BUSINESS ENTERPRISE. 10 (a) Offense defined.--A person commits a misdemeanor of the 11 second FELONY OF THE THIRD degree if, in the course of business, 12 he: (1) Fraudulently obtains, retains, attempts to obtain or 13

retain or aids another in fraudulently obtaining, retaining

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1 or attempting to obtain or retain OR RETAINS certification as 2 a minority business enterprise OR A WOMEN'S BUSINESS 3 ENTERPRISE. 4 (2) Willfully makes a false statement, whether by 5 affidavit, report or other representation, to an official or employee of a public body for the purpose of influencing the 6 7 certification or denial of certification of any business 8 entity as a minority business enterprise OR A WOMEN'S 9 BUSINESS ENTERPRISE. 10 (3) Willfully obstructs, impedes or attempts to obstruct 11 or impede OR IMPEDES any agency official or employee who is 12 investigating the qualifications of a business entity which 13 has requested certification as a minority business enterprise 14 OR A WOMEN'S BUSINESS ENTERPRISE. 15 (4) Fraudulently obtains, attempts to obtain or aids 16 another person in fraudulently obtaining or attempting to 17 obtain public moneys reserved for or allocated or available 18 to minority business enterprises OR WOMEN'S BUSINESS <----19 ENTERPRISES. (b) Definitions. -- As used in this section the following 20 21 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this 22 subsection: 23 "Certification." A determination made by a public body that a business entity is a minority business enterprise for whatever 24 25 purpose. 26 "Control." The exclusive or ultimate and sole control of the 27 business including, but not limited to, capital investment and 28 all other financial, property, acquisition, contract negotiation, legal matters, officer-director-employee selection 29 and comprehensive hiring, operating responsibility, cost-control 30

- 1 matters, income and dividend matters, financial transactions and
- 2 rights of other shareholders or joint partners. CONTROL SHALL BE <-
- 3 REAL, SUBSTANTIAL AND CONTINUING NOT PRO FORMA. CONTROL SHALL
- 4 INCLUDE THE POWER TO DIRECT OR CAUSE THE DIRECTION OF THE
- 5 MANAGEMENT AND POLICIES OF THE BUSINESS AND TO MAKE THE DAY-TO-
- 6 DAY AS WELL AS MAJOR DECISIONS IN MATTERS OF POLICY, MANAGEMENT
- 7 AND OPERATIONS. CONTROL SHALL BE EXEMPLIFIED BY POSSESSING THE
- 8 REQUISITE KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERTISE TO RUN THE PARTICULAR BUSINESS
- 9 AND CONTROL SHALL NOT INCLUDE SIMPLE MAJORITY OR ABSENTEE
- 10 OWNERSHIP. FURTHER, CONTROL BY A SOCIALLY AND ECONOMICALLY
- 11 <u>DISADVANTAGED INDIVIDUAL OR WOMAN SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO EXIST</u>
- 12 IN ANY CASE WHERE ANY NONMINORITY OWNER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE
- 13 BUSINESS IS DISPROPORTIONATELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE OPERATION OF
- 14 THE FIRM.
- 15 <u>"Minority business enterprise." A small business concern</u>
- 16 which is:
- 17 (1) A sole proprietorship, owned and controlled by a
- 18 socially and economically disadvantaged individual.
- 19 (2) A partnership or joint venture controlled by
- 20 <u>socially and economically disadvantaged individuals in which</u>
- 21 <u>51% of the beneficial ownership interest is held by socially</u>
- and economically disadvantaged individuals.
- 23 (3) A corporation or other entity controlled by socially
- 24 and economically disadvantaged individuals in which at least
- 25 <u>51% of the voting interest and 51% of the beneficial</u>
- 26 <u>ownership interest are held by socially and economically</u>
- 27 disadvantaged individuals.
- 28 "Public body." A department, bureau, agency, commission or
- 29 <u>other instrumentality of the Commonwealth, political</u>
- 30 subdivision, municipal authority or any wholly or partially

- 1 owned government corporation which enters into contracts.
- 2 <u>"Socially and economically disadvantaged individuals."</u>
- 3 Persons who are citizens of the United States and who are Black
- 4 Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian-Pacific
- 5 Americans, women and other minorities or persons found to be
- 6 disadvantaged by the Small Business Administration pursuant to
- 7 the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. § 631 et seg.).
- 8 "WOMEN'S BUSINESS ENTERPRISE." A SMALL BUSINESS CONCERN
- 9 WHICH IS AT LEAST 51% OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY WOMEN, OR, IN THE
- 10 CASE OF ANY PUBLICLY OWNED BUSINESS, AT LEAST 51% OF THE STOCK
- 11 OF WHICH IS OWNED BY ONE OR MORE WOMEN AND WHOSE MANAGEMENT AND
- 12 DAILY BUSINESS OPERATIONS ARE CONTROLLED BY ONE OR MORE OF THE
- 13 WOMEN WHO OWN IT.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
