AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for the designation of waterways
 - patrolmen; and providing for inchoate violations of this
- 4 title.

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- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 102 of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding definitions to read:
- 9 § 102. Definitions.
- 10 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 11 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
- 12 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when
- 13 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
- 14 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:
- 15 * * *
- 16 "Deputy waterways conservation officers." Officers formerly
- 17 designated as deputy waterways patrolmen appointed under section

- 1 305 (relating to deputy waterways patrolmen).
- 2 <u>"Deputy waterways patrolman." A deputy waterways</u>
- 3 <u>conservation officer</u>.
- 4 * * *
- 5 <u>"Waterways conservation officers." Officers formerly</u>
- 6 <u>designated as waterways patrolmen appointed under section 304</u>
- 7 <u>(relating to waterways patrolmen and employees).</u>
- 8 <u>"Waterways patrolman." A waterways conservation officer.</u>
- 9 Section 2. Title 30 is amended by adding sections to read:
- 10 § 307. Designation of law enforcement officers.
- 11 (a) Waterways patrolmen. -- Waterways patrolmen of the
- 12 <u>commission are designated as waterways conservation officers.</u>
- 13 The commission may substitute the term "waterways conservation
- 14 officer" for the term "waterways patrolmen" on its documents and
- 15 <u>materials on a schedule it deems appropriate.</u>
- (b) Deputy waterways patrolmen. -- Deputy waterways patrolmen
- 17 of the commission are designated deputy waterways conservation
- 18 officers. The commission may substitute the term "deputy
- 19 waterways conservation officer for the term deputy waterways
- 20 <u>patrolman" on its documents and materials on a schedule it deems</u>
- 21 appropriate.
- 22 (c) Saving provision. -- Prosecutions, enforcement actions and
- 23 other official duties of waterways conservation officers and
- 24 deputy waterways conservation officers shall not be affected by
- 25 the use of the designation waterways patrolmen or deputy
- 26 waterways patrolmen on forms, documents, materials, badges and
- 27 other items issued or prepared by the commission.
- 28 § 931. Inchoate violations.
- 29 <u>(a) General rule.--A person commits an inchoate violation of</u>
- 30 this title if the person:

- 1 (1) Attempts, as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 901 (relating
- 2 to criminal attempt), to violate any provision of this title
- 3 <u>or regulations promulgated under this title.</u>
- 4 (2) Solicits, as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 902 (relating
- 5 to criminal solicitation), another person to engage in
- 6 specific conduct in violation of this title or the
- 7 <u>regulations promulgated under this title.</u>
- 8 (3) Engages in a conspiracy, as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. §
- 9 903 (relating to criminal conspiracy), with another person or
- 10 persons to violate this title or the regulations promulgated
- 11 <u>thereunder</u>.
- 12 (b) Grading. -- Inchoate violations of this title and the
- 13 regulations promulgated under this title are offenses of the
- 14 same grade or degree as the most serious violation which is
- 15 <u>attempted or solicited or which is the object of a conspiracy.</u>
- 16 If the particular conduct charged as an inchoate violation of
- 17 this title is inherently unlikely to result or culminate in a
- 18 violation of this title or the regulations promulgated under
- 19 this title, the court or issuing authority may dismiss the
- 20 prosecution.
- 21 (c) Defense.--It is a defense to a charge under this section
- 22 that if the object of the attempt, solicitation or conspiracy
- 23 were achieved, the actor would not be quilty of a violation of
- 24 this title or the regulations promulgated under this title.
- 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
