## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, making the registration
- 3 number prima facie evidence that the owner was operating the
- 4 vehicle.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 6143 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes, amended December 20, 1982 (P.L.1409,
- 9 No.326), is amended to read:
- 10 § 6143. Registration number as prima facie evidence of
- operation of vehicle.
- [(a) General rule.--]In any action or proceeding for the
- 13 recovery of a civil penalty for an infraction of the provisions
- 14 of any law relating to the ownership or operation of any
- 15 conveyance by air, land or water or any game or fish law or any
- 16 local ordinance, rule or regulation relating thereto, the
- 17 registration number displayed on a conveyance shall [sustain an
- 18 inference | be prima facie evidence that the person to whom the

- 1 registration number was officially assigned is the owner of the
- 2 conveyance and was then operating the conveyance.
- 3 [(b) Inference overcome by testimony of owner.--If at any
- 4 proceeding under subsection (a) the owner testifies that the
- 5 owner was not operating the conveyance at the time of the
- 6 alleged infraction and submits to an examination as to who at
- 7 the time was operating the conveyance and reveals the name and
- 8 residence address of the person, if known, then the inference
- 9 arising from the registration number shall be overcome.
- 10 (c) Inference overcome by verified statement of owner.--If
- 11 the proceeding under subsection (a) is commenced in a county
- 12 other than that of the residence of the owner and a verified
- 13 written statement setting forth the facts set forth in
- 14 subsection (b) is forwarded by the owner to the tribunal, the
- 15 inference arising from the registration number shall be
- 16 overcome.]
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
