AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 17, 1956 (1955 P.L.1609, No.537), 2 entitled "An act to promote the welfare of the people of the 3 Commonwealth by the reduction of unemployment in certain 4 areas of the Commonwealth determined to be critical economic 5 areas; providing for the establishment of industrial development projects in such areas; creating The Pennsylvania Industrial Development Authority as a body corporate and 7 8 politic with power to allocate funds for and make secured 9 loans to industrial development agencies for the payment of a 10 part of the cost of industrial development projects in critical economic areas; authorizing the Authority to enter 11 12 into agreements with the Government of the United States or 13 any Federal agency or industrial development agency; empowering the Authority to take title to, sell, convey and 14 15 lease industrial development projects where necessary to 16 protect loans made by the Pennsylvania Industrial Development 17 Authority on industrial development projects; providing that no debt of the Commonwealth, its municipalities or political 18 19 subdivisions shall be incurred in the exercise of any powers 20 granted by this act; and providing for the examination of the accounts and affairs of the Authority; and making an 21 22 appropriation, "further defining the term "industrial 23 development project."

- 4 Section 3. Definitions.--The following terms, whenever used
- 5 or referred to in this act, shall have the following meanings,
- 6 except in those instances where the context clearly indicates
- 7 otherwise:

- 9 (i) The term "industrial development project" shall mean any
- 10 land, site, structure, facility or undertaking (including in the
- 11 case of the garment industry, machinery and equipment)
- 12 comprising or being connected with or being a part of (i) an
- 13 industrial enterprise, (ii) a manufacturing enterprise, (iii) a
- 14 research and development enterprise, or (iv) an agricultural
- 15 enterprise, established or to be established by an industrial
- 16 development agency in a critical economic area.

- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
