5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	<u>§ 5509.1. Vandalism of grave markers.</u>
9	<u>A person commits a misdemeanor of the third degree if he</u>
LO	intentionally topples, damages or defaces any grave marker or
L1	gravestone located in any public or private cemetery.

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
