AN ACT

1 Authorizing the Liquor Control Board to improve its computer  
2 system in accordance with the findings of a feasibility  
3 study.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. On the basis of the results of a feasibility  
7 study conducted for purpose of improving its computer system to  
8 more effectively conduct its work, the Liquor Control Board is  
9 authorized to take any action and make any purchases and  
10 expenditures as may be necessary to implement the findings of  
11 that study. The purchases and expenditures shall be through the  
12 Department of General Services in the manner provided by law.

13 Section 2. The Liquor Control Board is hereby authorized to  
14 expend from the State Stores Fund as much money as may be  
15 necessary to improve its computer system as provided in this  
16 act.

17 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
