## AN ACT

1	Amending the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937
2	P.L.2897, No.1), entitled "An act establishing a system of
3	unemployment compensation to be administered by the
4	Department of Labor and Industry and its existing and newly
5	created agencies with personnel (with certain exceptions)
6	selected on a civil service basis; requiring employers to
7	keep records and make reports, and certain employers to pay
8	contributions based on payrolls to provide moneys for the
9	payment of compensation to certain unemployed persons;
L 0	providing procedure and administrative details for the
L1	determination, payment and collection of such contributions
L2	and the payment of such compensation; providing for
L3	cooperation with the Federal Government and its agencies;
L4	creating certain special funds in the custody of the State
L5	Treasurer; and prescribing penalties, requiring all
L6	claimants to serve one week on jury duty.
L7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
L8	hereby enacts as follows:
L9	Section 1. The act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937
20	P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation Law, is
21	amended by adding a section to read:
22	Section 409. Required Jury Duty (a) Notwithstanding any
23	provision of this act, no claimant shall collect any benefits
24	under this act until he has served one week of jury duty during

- 1 <u>his benefit year.</u>
- (b) The department shall, in the manner provided by law, 2
- 3 promulgate the rules, regulations and forms necessary to carry
- 4 <u>out this section</u>.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in six months.
