AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, requiring school buses to stop at all railroad  
3 crossings.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3342 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:

8 § 3342. Vehicles required to stop at railroad crossings.

10 (a.1) School buses.--The drivers of school buses shall stop  
11 before crossing any railroad grade crossing or track or tracks  
12 of a railroad.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
