AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for enforcement of traffic regulations on
3 private property.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 6113 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 6113. Control of public travel on private property by owner.

9 (a) General rule.--Nothing in this title shall be construed
10 to prevent the owner of real property used by the public for
11 purposes of vehicular travel by permission of the owner, and not
12 as a matter of right, from prohibiting such use, or from
13 requiring other or different or additional conditions than those
14 specified in this title, or otherwise regulating such use as may
15 seem best to such owner.

16 (b) Enforcement.--The owner of real property which is ten
17 contiguous acres or more in size may request the local authority
18 to enforce the observance of speed limits and traffic-control

1 devices on his property, providing the property has been posted
2 in accordance with departmental regulations.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
