- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for enforcement of traffic regulations on
- 3 private property.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6113 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 6113. Control of public travel on private property by owner.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Nothing in this title shall be construed
- 10 to prevent the owner of real property used by the public for
- 11 purposes of vehicular travel by permission of the owner, and not
- 12 as a matter of right, from prohibiting such use, or from
- 13 requiring other or different or additional conditions than those
- 14 specified in this title, or otherwise regulating such use as may
- 15 seem best to such owner.
- 16 (b) Enforcement.--The owner of real property which is ten
- 17 contiguous acres or more in size may request the local authority
- 18 to enforce the observance of speed limits and traffic-control

- 1 devices on his property, providing the property has been posted
- 2 <u>in accordance with departmental regulations</u>.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
