AN ACT

- 1 Declaring and adopting the song "We Are the People," by David L.
- 2 Clark, as the State song of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The song "We Are the People," by David L. Clark,
- 6 is hereby adopted as the State song of Pennsylvania and shall be
- 7 the official song for all public purposes. The words of the song
- 8 are as follows:
- 9 "WE ARE THE PEOPLE"
- 10 Verse 1:
- 11 You have blessed us with mountains and valleys, to reveal to us
- 12 your majesty and power.
- 13 You can see, Oh God, we expect you to give us a helping hand.
- 14 You have favored us with the Mountain Laurel flower, and we are
- 15 so grateful.
- 16 You can see, Oh God, we depend on you to provide our daily need.
- 17 Chorus:

- 1 We are the people who need a helping hand
- We are the family who need your strength to stand.
- 3 We are the children who need a helping hand.
- 4 As life goes on we must try to get along.
- 5 You can see, Oh God, that we have a need.
- 6 We are the people, we are the people, oh yes.
- We need a helping hand, someone to understand today.
- 8 Verse 2:
- 9 You have appointed us with the Hemlock tree and we are so
- 10 thankful.
- 11 You can see, Oh God, we believe you will guide us in all our
- ways.
- 13 You have granted us with the Ruffled Grouse bird and we are so
- 14 delighted.
- 15 You can see, Oh God, without your help we limit ourselves.
- 16 (Chorus)
- 17 Verse 3:
- 18 You have destined us with virtue and liberty, and we are so
- 19 appreciative.
- 20 You can see, Oh God, that our hope and trust is forever in
- Thee.
- 22 You have freshened our lakes and rivers with the Brook Trout
- fish, and we are so obliged.
- 24 You can see, Oh god, we are gratified by the resources that come
- 25 from Thee.
- 26 (Chorus)
- 27 Verse 4:
- 28 You have beautified our forests and parks with the Whitetail
- Deer, and we are so beholden.
- 30 You can see, Oh God, we regard our animal life in respect to

- 1 Thee.
- 2 You have enlightened our night season with the Firefly insect
- 3 and we are so excited.
- 4 You can see, Oh God, we accept Thy Word as a lamp unto our feet
- 5 and light to our pathway.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
