## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, increasing the penalty for fleeing or attempting to
- 3 elude a police officer.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3733 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3733. Fleeing or attempting to elude police officer.
- 9 (a) Offense defined.--Any driver of a motor vehicle who
- 10 willfully fails or refuses to bring his vehicle to a stop, or
- 11 who otherwise flees or attempts to elude a pursuing police
- 12 vehicle, when given visual or audible signal to bring the
- 13 vehicle to a stop, is guilty of a [summary offense and shall,
- 14 upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$200] misdemeanor
- 15 of the second degree.
- 16 (b) Signal by police officer.--The signal given by the
- 17 police officer may be by hand, voice, emergency lights or siren.
- 18 (c) Defenses.--It is a defense to a prosecution under this

- 1 section that the pursuing police vehicle was not clearly
- 2 identifiable by its markings or, if unmarked, was not occupied
- 3 by a police officer who was in uniform and displaying a badge or
- 4 other sign of authority.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
