AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for the occupancy of trailing
- 3 vehicles.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 8 § 102. Definitions.
- 9 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 10 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
- 11 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when
- 12 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
- 13 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:
- 14 * * *
- 15 "Trailing vehicle." A vehicle that cannot be steered by an
- 16 occupant of the vehicle, which vehicle is being drawn behind a
- 17 motor vehicle.

- 1 Section 2. Section 3706 of Title 75 is amended to read:
- 2 § 3706. Riding in [house trailers, mobile homes or boats on
- 3 trailers] trailing vehicles.
- 4 (a) General rule. -- No person [or persons] shall occupy a
- 5 [house trailer, mobile home or boat on a trailer while it is
- 6 being moved upon] trailing vehicle on a highway.
- 7 (b) Towing prohibited. -- No person shall tow on a highway a
- 8 [house trailer, mobile home or boat on a trailer] trailing
- 9 <u>vehicle</u> occupied by a passenger [or passengers].
- 10 (c) Exception for certain semitrailers.--A semitrailer which
- 11 is attached to a truck in an articulating manner by means of a
- 12 fifth wheel semitrailer coupling device attached to the carrying
- 13 compartment of the truck may be occupied by a passenger or
- 14 passengers. The coupling device shall have a two-inch or larger
- 15 kingpin. All windows shall have safety glass. Some means of
- 16 electrical or electronic communications approved by the
- 17 department is required between the cab of the truck and the
- 18 semitrailer.
- 19 (d) Exception for other vehicles. -- Subsections (a) and (b)
- 20 do not apply to trailing vehicles drawn by implements of
- 21 <u>husbandry or trailers approved by the Public Utility Commission</u>
- 22 for carrying passengers.
- 23 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
