AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, providing for special registration plates for  
3 senior citizens.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1346. Senior citizen plates.

9 On the application of any person 65 years of age or over,  
10 with information satisfactory to the department and accompanied  
11 by the appropriate fee, the department shall issue special  
12 registration plates designating the vehicle as belonging to a  
13 senior citizen, which shall have the same effect as regular  
14 registration plates. The registration plates may have such  
15 distinctive colors as the department may determine and shall  
16 have the words "senior citizen" in at least ten-point bold type  
17 inscribed at the bottom.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
