18	(c) Fire and emergency standardsNotwithstanding any other
19	provision of law other than standards required by the Federal
20	Government as a condition of participation by that type of
21	health care facility in the Medicare or Medicaid program, no

health care facility shall be required to satisfy any regulation 1 relating to fire or similar emergency circumstance more 2 3 stringent than those required of hospitals by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals [and the department 4 shall adopt and enforce the appropriate standards.] provided 5 those regulations exceed any local fire code, building code or 6 emergency standards enforced in the municipality in which the 7 8 health care facility is located or is to be constructed. The 9 department shall adopt and enforce the appropriate standards. 10 Where such local codes exceed the regulations of the Joint 11 Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals, the local codes shall 12 supersede the regulations of the Joint Commission on 13 Accreditation of Hospitals and be enforced.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
